I have written a separate letter to inform you about important changes regarding pupil attendance which have been implemented across Cumberland schools in line with statutory guidance from September 2024. The letter explains that we will be contacting a small number of families by telephone next week to discuss their current attendance an make sure that they are not at risk of a fixed penalty notice.

Sixty-three of our pupils managed 100% attendance last half term which was most pleasing. Attendance was much improved on the same half term last year with an overall rate of 97.2%. Remarkably, Y1 had an outstanding attendance of 99.45%. Keep up the good work!
